The KRACK OTA can be applied to CC5000-10 Lollipop version 2.0.1.8 or later.

#### Overview

This software update addresses the KRACK vulnerability on CC5000-10 using Android Lollipop.

This software update replaces ONLY the Fusion Wi-Fi Stack.

# OTA Loading procedure

The OTA package can loaded from Recovery Mode using an SDCard:

- 1. Load an SD Card onto a standard computer.
- 2. Format the SD Card as FAT32.
- 3. Copy the CC5000\_OTA\_KRACK\_11162017.zip OTA file to the SD Card.
- 4. Remove the SD Card from the PC, and Insert it into SD Card slot in the back of the CC5000-10 device.
- 5. Remove power from the device, and re-apply power while holding the '2' button in the back of the device. Keep the button pressed until the recovery screen appears.
- 6. Once the Recovery Screen appears, use the '1' button to scroll through the options and select "Apply Update from SD Card"
- 7. The contents of the SD card will be displayed. Select the desired file.
- 8. Wait for the updating process to complete until the message "Update complete" is displayed.
- 9. Reboot the device once the update process has been completed, either by selecting the 'Reboot' option from the list or by cycling power to the device.
