
Release Notes – WT6000 Downgrade from Nougat to Lollipop

Important Notes

Use the UPL(WT6000_N2L_Downgrade.upl) file to downgrade from Android N to Android L through EMM or internal storage.

Warning / Known issue: Downgrade using the package (WT6000_N2L_FPU_AOSP_410_03.zip file) directly is not supported. If you try to downgrade with the package without the UPL file, the device will become stuck at the splash screen

Installation Instructions

EMM downgrade from Android N to Android L steps – Device with Non-Encrypted Data

1. Extract the WT6000_N2L_Downgrade.zip file contents.
2. Push the extracted files (WT6000_N2L_Downgrade.upl and WT6000_N2L_FPU_AOSP_410_03.zip) to root of the WT6000 internal storage.
3. Invoke the downgrade using the WT6000_N2L_Downgrade.upl file

Known Issues and Limitations

1. Upgrading / downgrading Android L SKUs (WT60A0-TS0LEUS, WT60A0-TS0LEWR) to Android N will cause the Data partition to be reformatted.
2. Downgrading Android N SKUs (WT60A0-TS2NEUS, WT60A0-TS2NEWR) to Android L is not supported. This error message will appear: “This package only for standard SKU”
