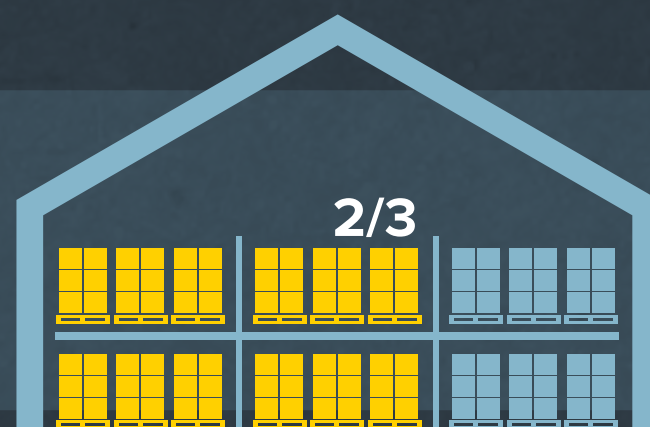

TRACKING ALERT:

IN 2013, ONLY TWO-THIRDS OF ITEMS HANDLED WERE BARCODED. IT IS EXPECTED THAT THIS SHOULD GROW UP TO 83% BY 2018.¹



COMPLIANCE ALERT:

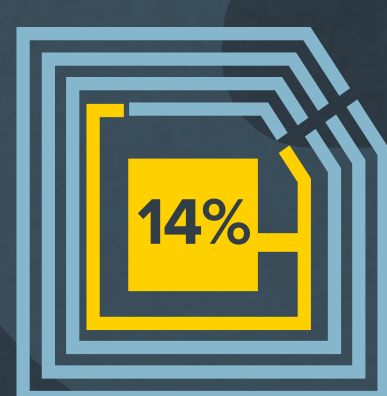
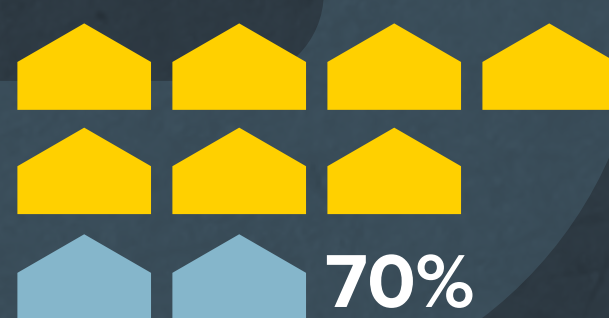
THE MAJORITY OF WAREHOUSES ARE ONLY PARTIALLY AUTOMATED.²

RFID TECHNOLOGY IS BEING ADOPTED AT A RATE OF 14% PER YEAR, ACCORDING TO ABI RESEARCH.⁴

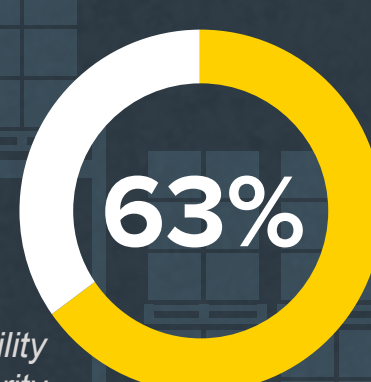
RECALL ALERT:

IF YOUR COMPANY HAD TO ISSUE A RECALL, HOW QUICKLY COULD YOU GET IT DONE?

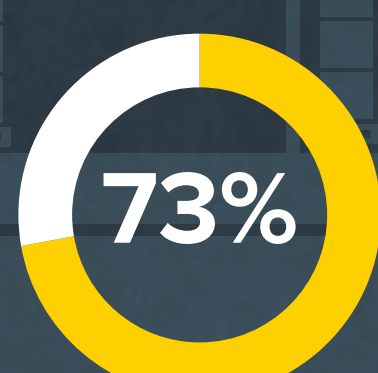


CLOSING THE GAPS

In a survey by the Aberdeen group, out of 149 companies with global supply chains, 63% of respondents stated that supply chain visibility was a high priority.⁵

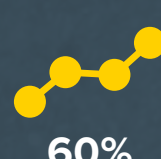

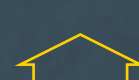
