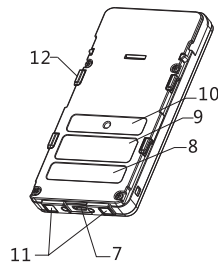

## FEATURES



- 1 Charging LED - Red - charging. Green - Fully charged.
- 2 Power Button - Press and hold to turn on or off.
- 3 Magnetic Stripe Card Slot
- 4 Display

- 6 Keypad

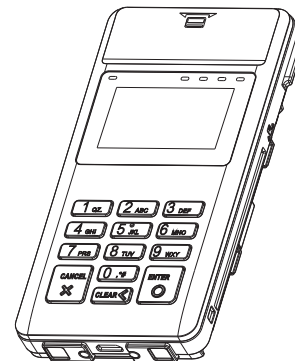


- 7 microUSB Connector

### Display Icons

- Bluetooth - Indicates that the PD40 is connected to a Bluetooth device.
- USB - Indicates the PD40 is connected to a computer using USB connection.
- IC State - Indicates that a Smart Card is inserted into the slot.
- Battery Charge - Indicates the battery charge level.
- Blinking Battery - Power is less than 15%.
- Battery Animation - Battery is charging.
- Lock - Keypad is locked. Press power key to unlock.

# PD40 QUICK START GUIDE



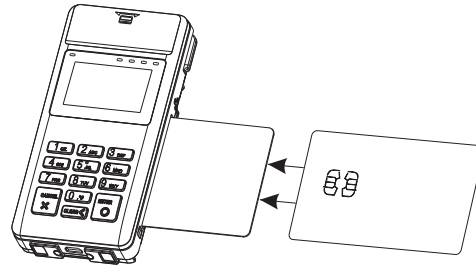
## MAGNETIC STRIPE CARD OPERATION

1. Launch a transaction application on the mobile device and initiate a credit or debit transaction.
2. Hand the PD40 to the customer.
3. On the PD40, swipe the credit or debit card through the magnetic stripe reader (MSR) slot, orienting the magnetic stripe as shown.
4. For credit transaction the customer may need to sign on the mobile device screen.
5. For debit transactions, the customer enters a PIN on the PD40 keypad following the instructions on the display.



## SMART CARD OPERATION

1. Launch a transaction application on the mobile device and initiate a credit or debit transaction.
2. Hand the PD40 to the customer.
3. The customer inserts the Smart card into the slot, orienting the card as shown below.
  - 4a. For EMV Chip & Sign transactions, the customer may need to sign on the mobile computer display/screen.
  - 4b. For EMV Chip & PIN transactions, the customer enters a PIN on the PD40 keypad following the instructions on the display.
5. Follow the screen prompt for when to remove the Smart card from the PD40.



## BLUETOOTH PAIRING

Bluetooth pairing and communication may vary depending upon the mobile device being used. Refer to the mobile device's User Guide for more information.

1. On the mobile device, enable Bluetooth.
2. Turn on the PD40. The Bluetooth icon appears.
3. On the mobile device, perform a Bluetooth discovery.
4. Select the PD40 (MPOS-xxxxxxx).
5. Key in six digit numbers shown on host device screen.
6. Complete connection.

## BLUETOOTH SCAN AND PAIR

If the mobile device supports the Scan and Pair Bluetooth pairing feature, scan the Bluetooth MAC Address bar code on the back of the PD40 to pair the mobile device and the PD40.

1. Turn on Bluetooth.
2. On the mobile computer, launch an application that initiates Bluetooth pairing.
3. Point the mobile computer scanner at the Bluetooth MAC address bar code on the back of the PD40.
4. Press the scan button to read the bar code. Bluetooth pairing occurs.
