Zebra Local License Server – Upgrade Instructions

If you already have an older version 2.0 (or below) of the local license server and would like to upgrade to the version 2.1, follow the below steps. The data in the server persists after the upgrade.

Step 1: License Server Components – Upgrade:

Before you upgrade, you need to stop and unregister the server and you can do that in the command prompt (zebra_local_license_server.exe) user interface options

- 1. Perform the sync with the Licensing Portal by stopping (option 3) and starting the server (option 1)
- 2. Stop and Unregister the Server as a Windows Service (option 4).
- 3. Exit the Interface (option 0).
- 4. Install the new executable (zebra_lls_installer_2.1.exe).
- 5. Update the zebrals.settings file with the Ethernet MAC address of the host machine (Refer 'Configuring the Local License Server' section in the Admin guide).
- 6. Register the Server and start it (Option Z).

Step 2: License Server Manager UI - Upgrade:

- 1. Stop the Apache service.
- 2. Delete the old flsm.war file and the flsm folder in \Tomcat 8.5\webapps folder.
- 3. Copy the new flsm.war file from the \ui folder into the \Tomcat 8.5\webapps folder.
- 4. Start the Apache service.

Validation:

Upon successful upgrade, the command prompt UI will show the version number 2.0 in the header section.
