

# **Enterprise Browser 3.2.5.0 for Android devices**

Release Notes - July, 2021

### **Highlights**

- Supports Zebra devices running Android 11
- Pre-licensed for MC33ax devices
- Support for three new configuration parameters via config.xml tags

### **Device Support**

- Supports Zebra devices running Android 11 and Android 10 only
- Device support dropped for devices running Android 9.x (Pie) and earlier

## **New in Enterprise Browser 3.2.5.0**

#### Pre-licensed for MC33ax

A license for the Zebra EMC33ax device is included when Enterprise Browser 3.2.5 (or later) is installed; no product registration page is shown when EB is launched on the device.

Two more configuration parameters are added in Config.xml to switch between on-screen keyboards(IME) while launching and exiting Enterprise browser. See below.

#### **Keyboard Switching**

To switch between two different on-screen Keyboards (IMEs)

When EB is launched or when EB comes to the foreground, use the following tag to set the IME to be used: < SetkeyboardOnLaunchOrForeground value =" "/>

When EB exits or when EB goes to the background, use the following tag to set the IME to be used: <SetkeyboardOnExitOrBackground value =" "/>

One more configuration parameter has been added to make the path of the Dom Injection file AKA appConfigurationFile path configurable. In earlier releases, after generating the app configuration file from EAC(Enterprise Application Configurator), user must place this file in Internal storage /Android/Data/com.symbol.enterprisebrowser directory. Now this file path has been made configurable. If your EMM does not support Internal storage /Android/Data/com.symbol.enterprisebrowser directory, please put this file in Internal storage /EnterpriseBrowser folder and refer to that path in config.xml as PRIMARYDIR.

#### **DOMInjectionUtilty**

appConfigFilePath = file path of the app configuration file generated by EAC tool

| <b>Default value for <mobileeditdisabledwidth> c</mobileeditdisabledwidth></b> onfig tag for SAP bundle has been changed to <b>"auto"</b> (formerly "none").  |

| <b>Zebra recommends against the use of alert boxes</b> to display any information in Enterprise Browser apps used in production environments as it might halt execution of the app.   |
| For access to Enterprise Keyboard SAP layouts, encrypted files in the SAP bundle must be pushed to the device.  |
| <b>Debug buttons and AddressBar</b> are not designed for use in <b>production environments</b> and can result in undesirable behavior.  |
| <asrpreferoffline> tag is no longer supported</asrpreferoffline>  |
| If using the EB installed directory(/Android/Data/com.symbol.enterprisebrowser/) for mass deployment of EB configuration files, some EMM systems might not support this path because of Android storage restrictions introduced in Android 11. In such cases, move configuration files to the path: |
