Installation

The following software packages must be installed prior to the installation of the Platform SDK for MC18. Most are available as a download from Microsoft's website.

- Microsoft Windows 2000, Windows XP or Windows Vista or Windows 7 or Windows 8 Operating Systems
- Microsoft ActiveSync 4.5 or higher.
- Microsoft Visual Studio 2005 with SP1 or Microsoft Visual Studio 2008.

NOTE: Before installing any version of MC18 PSDK, please uninstall any earlier versions of the same.

NOTE: MC18 PSDK installation process fails if Microsoft Visual Sudio 2003 is installed together with Visual Sudio 2008 on the same PC.

NOTE: MC18 PSDK installation (exe version) process fails on Windows 2008 server.

Once this package has been installed, Microsoft Visual Studio IDE will contain a new selection for the Symbol MC18N0 Windows CE7.0 PSDK in the "Build->Configuration Manager" menu field. This entry must be selected when creating and debugging applications for MC18 device.
