5 Installation

The following software packages must be installed prior to the installation of the Platform SDK for WT41N0c70. Most are available as a download from Microsofti; 1/2s website.

- Microsoft Windows 7, Microsoft Windows 2000, Windows XP or Windows Vista Operating Systems
- Microsoft ActiveSync 4.5 or higher.
- Microsoft Visual Studio 2005 with SP1 or Microsoft Visual Studio 2008.

NOTE: Before installing any version of WT41N0 PSDK, please uninstall any earlier versions of the same.

NOTE: WT41N0c70 PSDK installation process fails if Microsoft Visual Studio 2003 is installed together with Visual Studio 2008 on the same PC.

Once this package has been installed, Microsoft Visual Studio IDE will contain a new selection for the WT41N0 Windows CE7.0 PSDK in the "Build->Configuration Manager" menu field. This entry must be selected when creating and debugging applications for WT41N0 device.
