Fixes in this Release

- Fix no display on a DisplayPort Monitor after docking and coming to suspend state resume condition.
- Fix display flash when playing video full screen with media player when there is no Aero selected.
- Restore the "Power Settings" button in Intel Common User Interface (CUI).
- Fix spelling of the word "Hertz" in Intel CUI.
- Fix rotation feature section icon disappears after resuming from suspend state.
- Fix Screen Resolution issue that resets the display to 800X600 after resuming from hibernate or suspend state.
- Fix Rotation setting persist failure at 90 or 270 degrees if EXTEND mode is enabled.
- Fix resume from hibernate issue after upgrade to Windows Vista SP1.
- Fix display driver stopped responding error when switching to Clone mode.

Known Issues and Limitations

- An exclamation mark is displayed for the Video Controllers in the Device Manager after installing the graphics driver via the Have Disk method.
- Audio can not be heard after resuming from suspend state.

Installation Instructions

To install this version update, perform the following steps:

1. Download the update (J3400_Graphics_Vista_v1861.zip) to the directory location of your choice.
2. Unzip the file to a location on your local drive.
3. Double-click on the installer (Setup.exe) and follow the prompts.
