Fixes in this Release

- Fixed a problem with the MotionCM SDK when running on 64-bit Windows versions.

What's New In This Release

- Users may now have APN passwords encrypted so they will not appear in the Profiles.txt file in clear text. To encrypt an APN password, use the MotionCM Networks page to modify or create the profile and surround the password with brackets. For example, to encrypt "MyPassword", enter it as "[MyPassword]". The resulting password entry that is stored in the file will be encrypted except for the brackets, which will remain readable.

Known Issues and Limitations

- This version will only install on Motion Computing Tablet PCs with the Sierra Wireless MC8355 (Gobi 3000) module.
- The MotionCM installer keeps intact any existing Profiles.txt and Carriers.txt configuration files. If you want to install the latest versions of these files and have no need to preserve the older files, you must first manually delete the existing files from C:\MotionCM.

Installation and Configuration Instructions

To install Motion CM 3.2.4.4, perform the following steps:

1. Download the update and save to the directory location of your choice.
2. Unzip the file to a location on your local drive.
3. Double-click the installer (MotionCMSetup3020404.msi) and follow the prompts.
