4 Installation

The following software packages must be installed prior to the installation of the Platform SDK for MC9200c70. Most are available as a download from Microsoft's website.

- Microsoft Windows 2000, Windows XP, Windows Vista Operating Systems
- Microsoft ActiveSync 4.5 or higher.
- Microsoft Visual Studio 2008 with SP1.

NOTE: Before installing any version of the MC9200c70 PSDK, please uninstall any earlier versions of the same.

NOTE: MC9200c70 PSDK installation process fails if Microsoft Visual Studio 2003 is installed together with Visual Studio 2008 on the same PC.

Once this package has been installed, Microsoft Visual Studio IDE will contain a new selection for the MC9200c70 in the "Build->Configuration Manager" menu field. This entry must be selected when creating and debugging applications for MC9200c70 device.
