Installation Instructions

For NORMAL installation of the PATCH:

- 1. Connect device to PC using ActiveSync. To make the SB1 device connectable through ActiveSync, first deploy the "ActiveSyncEnable.apf" package file which is part of the "Software Development Toolkit v2.4 for SB1" available on support central.
- 2. Once SB1 is connected to PC through ActiveSync, extract contents of the "SPR27338.apf" file and copy to "\Application" folder.
- 3. Do a terminal reboot by pressing and holding the front trigger and home keys simultaneously.

For MSP or REMOTE installation of the PATCH:

- 1. Upload the "SPR27338.apf" package into MSP server.
- 2. Create a bundle using the "SPR27338.apf" package
- 3. Create a staging profile using "SPR27338.apf" bundle.
- Generate PDF barcode.
- 4. Scan barcode using RD Client utility from device to deploy the package.
- 5. Once the package is successfully deployed on the device, terminal will do a reboot.
