DEVICE SETUP

Enterprise Keyboard Device Runtime Installation

Manually installing the Enterprise Keyboard OS update

- Connect the Zebra Android device to the PC.
- Copy EnterpriseKeyboard_OsUpdatePackage_v1.3.0.1.zip to SDCard on device.
- Reboot the device in the recovery mode.
- Follow the instructions to select apply update from SDCard.
- Select EnterpriseKeyboard OSUpdatePackage.zip.
- Wait for the device to complete the installation.
- · Reboot the device.
- This completes Enterprise Keyboard device runtime installation.

KNOWN ISSUES

- Autocapitalization doesn't work if you navigate away from the alpha keyboard prior to typing.
- . Keyboard popups disappear entirely if you swipe to symbols and back to alpha.
- The current keyboard layout (non QWERTY) does not persist when moving from portrait to landscape (or vice versa). The keyboard always returns to the QWERTY layout after a screen rotation event..
