New in Enterprise Keyboard 3.9

Key Repetition Feature

Supports key repetition on long-press action, including keycodes, Unicode characters and upper/lower case letters.

Macro Actions

Now supports Macros or series of actions to combine multiple keycodes, presses or actions into a single action.

Zebra MDNA Enterprise Licensing support

Zebra Professional-series devices, including the TC21 and TC26, require purchase of a license to use Enterprise Keyboard. These devices arrive with a non-functional EKB "dummy" client, which must be replaced with the functional EKB v3.9 (or later) client after purchase of the Zebra MDNA Enterprise license. Until then, EKB displays a "license required" prompt whenever an app focuses on a text input box.

NOTE: New features of EKB 3.9 must be implemented in custom layouts using Enterprise Keyboard Designer 1.9 (or later)
