Important News

- **Supported Devices:** For a complete list of supported devices, visit the <u>TechDocs</u> webpage.
- Starting from EHS version 2.7 two separate APKs; EHS_020703_A.apk and EHS_020703_B.apk, are available in Support Portal to be selected depending upon the Zebra device used.
 - EHS_020703_A.apk: for all Android Lollipop, Marshmallow and Nougat devices except TC20/TC25 Nougat.
 - EHS_020703_B.apk: for TC20/TC25 Nougat devices only.
- EHS support for all KitKat (Android 4.4.2) devices has been terminated Starting from EHS v2.7, only Lollipop and higher devices are supported. EHS v2.6 is the last version that supports Android KitKat devices. EHS v2.6 and earlier versions are still available on the Support Portal for use on KitKat devices.
- EHS Support for all Jelly Bean (Android 4.1.2) devices and TC70 KitKat (Android 4.4.2) BSP version 112414 device is terminated in EHS version 2.5 EHS v2.5 supported KitKat (except TC70 KitKat BSP version 112414) and higher OS versions. EHS v2.4 and earlier versions will still be available on the Support Portal for use on Jelly Bean devices and TC70 KitKat BSP version 112414.
- EHS Installer apk release is terminated in EHS version 2.5 With the end of support for Jelly Bean devices and TC70 KitKat BSP version 112414, EHS v2.5 and higher will no longer distribute a separate installer APK for these devices. EHS v2.5 and higher will contain only one apk for all Zebra devices running KitKat (except TC70 KitKat BSP version 112414) and higher.

Introduction

Enterprise Home Screen (EHS) is a replacement application launcher for Zebra Android devices, designed to allow only specified applications to be launched.

Description

- Added support for TC51, TC56, TC70x, TC75x, TC20, TC25, MC33 Android Nougat 7.1.2 devices. For a complete list of supported devices, visit the <u>TechDocs</u> webpage.
- Starting from EHS version 2.7 two separate APKs; EHS_020703_A.apk and EHS_020703_B.apk, are available in Support Portal to be selected depending upon the Zebra device used.
 - EHS_020703_A.apk: for all Android Lollipop, Marshmallow and Nougat devices except TC20/TC25 Nougat.
 - EHS_020703_B.apk: for TC20/TC25 Nougat devices only.
- Removed Support for all KitKat (Android 4.4.2) devices. EHS v2.6 and earlier versions are still available on the Support Portal for use on those devices.
- Added a new feature to support enable/disable recent apps button in Android Nougat devices. By default, recent apps button is disabled by EHS in order to disable multi-window mode.
- Added a new feature to enable/disable logging in EHS and also an option to set maximum log file size. Once maximum log file size is reached it will be rolled over to a new file.
- Added support to display Battery Health Percentage under Battery info and Quick info screens on devices having Power Precision Plus battery type such as TC51 and TC56.
- Added a new feature to enable/disable wallpaper stretching to full screen. By default stretching is disabled so EHS home screen wallpaper is not extended over the title bar.
- Added support for VC80x Android Nougat 7.1.2 devices. (Updated January 2018)*

* New device approval has been received for this package. The approval did not require any software changes. If you have already installed the package, there is no need to download and install it again.

Device Compatibility

Installation Requirements

Enterprise Home Screen has minimal installation requirements. All that is required is a Zebra Android device running on Android Lollipop or higher.

Installation Instructions

- 1. Download the EHS zip file from Zebra Support Portal
- 2. Extract the contents of the zip file to a suitable location on your computer

3. Refer to the EHS Readme and the online <u>EHS User guide</u> for detailed installation instructions.

Usage Notes

1. To enable EHS secure mode, device root certificate has to be installed in the device in advance. Starting from Android N, installing device Root certificate using MDM Administrator is Obsoleted. Hence Cert Manager has to be used via StageNow or EMDK.

Known Issues

1. When Keyguard camera/search is disabled and the bypass key guard is enabled, if the device is rebooted from the device keyguard/lock screen (i.e. while being on the lock screen), the camera/search app might be permanently disabled. To overcome this issue, add the package name of Camera/Search app to the enabled app list in EHS (by adding inside "apps_enabled" tag in EHS configuration XML file).
