NOTE: See below for helpful information about some of the most common matters new users encounter:

Remember that a saved cart isn't a submitted order. If you received an order number listed on the Order Confirmation screen, your repair order was successfully submitted. If you clicked the Save & Exit button, your repair order has been saved, but not been submitted. Return to complete the order as appropriate.

Why am I being asked for a credit card or PO number? If you are asked for payment by purchase order or credit card for a device you believe is covered by warranty or contract, use the Dispute Entitlement option in the portal. Click [here](#) for instructions.

I'm receiving the 'Forbidden Error' message. This message may appear when accessing the portal from a bookmarked URL. Type the Repair Order Portal address directly into your browser. For example, for the English language portal, type <https://repair.zebra.com/enu>. Or access the portal from the [Request a Repair](#) page on Zebra.com. If you try these steps and get an error message ("We didn't recognize the username or password you entered."), you will need to register specifically for Portal access (see the following topic).

User ID, password, login, other error messages and system performance issues. You can obtain or change your password from links on the sign-in page. If that's not the solution, contact Zebra. Follow this [link](#) to find the right phone number. NOTE: One-time registration is required to use the Repair Order Portal, even for users who are set up for other Zebra sites and tools. Please use the 'Register' option on the [Request a Repair](#) page on Zebra.com, and a user ID and password will be emailed to you within 24 hours.
