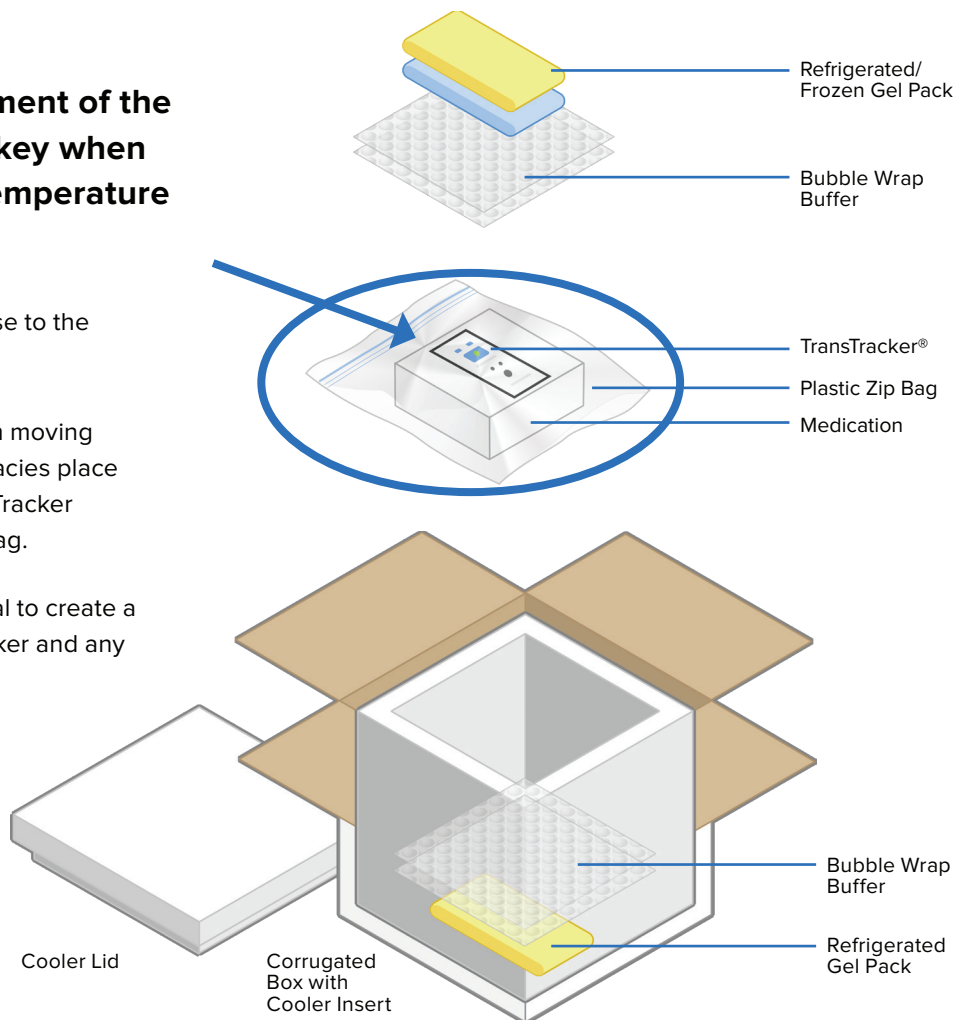


Placement Matters: TransTracker® Temperature Indicators

Including a TransTracker® in outgoing medication shipments gives your patients peace of mind with an easy-to-read visual cue of whether medication has gotten too hot or too cold while in transit.

Did you know that placement of the temperature indicator is key when monitoring medication temperature exposure during transit?

- 1** Place the TransTracker as close to the medication as possible.
- 2** To keep the TransTracker from moving during shipping, some pharmacies place the medication and the TransTracker together inside a plastic zip bag.
- 3** Use sufficient packing material to create a buffer between the TransTracker and any other gel packs.



TransTracker is an inexpensive, single-use temperature indicator that lets patients know if medication has experienced a temperature excursion during shipping.
